Ramsbury FC is not all about winning, but it is great when our teams achieve success. Our club is always competitive and win or lose every one of our teams always give their best. We are widely respected as Ramsbury FC teams are known to play fair and are tough to play against but are always welcoming to opposition when playing home matches at the Ramsbury Recreation Centre.

Last season all our teams continued to do their best with our U15s (now U16s) Div 2 Runners Up and promoted to Div 1. They are currently unbeaten and top of Div 1 in the Mid Wilts League having beaten teams like Corsham FC U16s, Bath Arsenal FC U16s and most recently Warminster FC U15s. They are managed by James Collister and Rob James with some players in the team since they were Ramsbury FC Under 6s!




Our U14s (now U15s) managed by Rich Gillard and Adam Blanchard won dramatically on the last day of the season to clinch the league title over fierce rivals Hungerford Town FC U14s. The picture left shows how proud all the team and their coaches were being awarded the North Wilts Youth League Div Champions Shield! Not only did our U15s and U14s teams do so well, but both our Under 8 teams won their Trophy Events at Foundation Park and our U9s got to their first final. We also had young Ramsbury FC players win players of the week at not one but two Swindon Town FC football camps.

Our men's team, who some of our coaches play with or have played for, had a superb season and were Div 1 Runners Up and were promoted to the Swindon and District Premier Division. Jas Walsh was also awarded top goal scorer in the league – another excellent result and shows the depth of quality Ramsbury FC has in both its youth and adult sections.

Under 7s Win Trophy Event at Foundation Park

Our youngest league team in the Club mirrored their predecessors, who are now our Under 8 Blues and Under 8 Whites, by winning their Trophy event at Foundation Park on Sunday 13th October 2024. The Under 7s did it in style by conceding only one goal and not losing a match!

Lead Coach Chris Roberts was delighted and so were both Assistant Coaches Rob Freeman and Georgian Radulescu. All Coaches, and the Team Secretary and Club Welfare Officer (CWO), Laurie Roberts, have put in a lot of time and effort through the Club Under 6 Development Programme and it is great to see the progress by the Under 7s and see them compete with much bigger clubs. I must not forget the parents who are hugely important in supporting Chris, George, Rob and the team in all that they do, win or lose, and have been key to all they have done.



The Under 6s Development Programme Continues to Flourish

Ramsbury FC are one of a few clubs that offer a comprehensive Under 6s Development Programme that caters for children of all ability in both Class R and Class 1. The Under 6s training is overseen by Level 1 Coach Jon Symon, who is also the Club Secretary, CWO and FA Accreditation lead, and he is supported by parent volunteers who go on to complete mandated DBS requirements and then First Aid and Safeguarding Children courses. All are all fully funded by Ramsbury FC to become fully qualified FA Youth Coaches and/or Team Secretaries.







Our current Under 6s cohort numbers 32 with 18 in Class R and 14 in Class 1 and we have 4 x superb volunteer coaches: Rupert McSheehy, Monty Halliday, Chloe Martin and Paddy Lowe.



Ramsbury FC Supports Duke of Edinburgh Silver and Bronze Award Volunteering

Ramsbury FC has a history of working with the Duke of Edinburgh scheme and young players like George Blanchard (pictured left) and Max Gillard have earned their Bronze Volunteering Award with the Club.

The Under 6 coaches are currently supported by 3 x Under 14 Duke of Edinburgh Bronze volunteers who complete 3 months of volunteering every Saturday for 90 minutes or more and help set up and clear away and are

brilliant examples to our young Under 6 players. They are all local and have played for Ramsbury FC and are a real credit to their parents: Ben Foley, Euan Holdsworth and Myles DeGouve. We are very lucky to have them and 2 more volunteers are scheduled to start in November!
